Highland Creek Public Meeting Set for June 8

The City of Carrollton recently selected Freese and Nichols, Inc. an engineering/architectural and environmental consulting firm to provide design for the Highland Creek drainage improvement project. The project will analyze the causes of the erosion problem along the creek, develop alternative solutions with the input of the residents, and design the project to meet the needs of the City and its residents.

Highland Creek residents are invited to a public meeting on Thursday, June 8 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the Frankford Village Branch Library in the Story Time room, 3030 Josey Lane, Suite 130. This meeting will be the first of a series of three meetings regarding the proposed improvements to Highland Creek.

At the June 8th meeting, residents will be asked to provide input on issues experienced along the creek. Technical staff from both the City and Freese and Nichols, Inc. will be on hand to introduce the public involvement process, and to assist in gaining resident input about this project.

After a brief introduction and project overview, residents will be asked to complete a comment sheet identifying their concerns and return the "Permission to Survey" form attached to this update. Residents will also have the opportunity to summarize specific concerns on a large location map of the project.

Residents will break into smaller discussion groups to further voice concerns and share ideas about the project.
