



# Dixon Branch Flood Study Public Meeting #2

## What is the Dixon Branch Flood Study?

The flood control solution for Dixon Branch on the City of Dallas Needs Inventory is the channel improvements recommended in a report completed in 1993. Based on public input this option has not been favored for some time.

Since flooding continues to occur, the City decided to update the previous study by looking at other alternatives to bring relief to the residents along Dixon Branch. In December 2007, an engineering contract was awarded to Freese and Nichols, Inc. to update the floodplain management study for Dixon Branch. The update involves evaluating the effectiveness of the previously recommended channel improvements, as well as looking at other potential solutions. The alternative solutions include buy-out, detention, diversion, and floodwall system.
