C1. Contractor Assurance Statements

The Deep East Texas Workforce Development Board assures the Commission that there is an executed contract in place with HR Solutions, Inc. (Marian West, PHR) in our area, which covers, at a minimum, all of the requirements of an Memoranda Of Understanding (MOU) for the following program(s): Food Stamp Employment and Training, TANF Choices, Workforce Investment Act (Title I), Rapid Response (Dislocated Worker) activities, the federal Trade Act services, Project Re-Integration of Offenders (RIO) operations, Wagner-Peyser Employment Services and Veterans' Employment and Training.

The Deep East Texas Workforce Development Board assures the Commission that there is an executed contract in place with East Texas Support Services in our area, which covers, at a minimum, all of the requirements of an MOU for the following program(s): Child Care, Child Care Quality.

C2. Memoranda of Understanding with Required and Optional Partners

No new or revised Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) are submitted.

Renewed MOUs are being submitted with the Women's Shelter of East Texas (required), and Burke Center (optional). A plan amendment will be submitted when MOUs are renewed with TWC for Unemployment Insurance Services (required), which expires 8/31/04, and Texas Rehabilitation Commission (optional), which expires 6/30/04.

No other MOUs are currently being pursued.

There is no AmeriCorps or other related volunteer service organization within the Board area with which the Board could partner. When such partnership opportunities become available in the area, the Board will pursue an MOU. The Board assures the Commission that it will post the website and address or 1-800 phone number for AmeriCorps in all resource areas for customers who want to access volunteer services.

There is no apprenticeship organization within the Board area with which the Board could partner. Following dialog with Board members, the Board has learned of no businesses interested in working with the DOL Bureau of Apprenticeship.
