Priority of Service Declaration for PY 2003

Declaration of Limited/Not Limited Funds

for the WIA Adult Program

Reference: The Workforce Investment Act (WIA), Section 134(d)(4)(E), and WIA Final Regulations, Preamble and Sub-part F, § 663.600.

General Information: WIA adult funding is generally limited due to the number of adults who could benefit from WIA services exceeding the availability of funding. However, conditions vary from one Local Workforce Development Area to another and funds may not be limited in all areas. Boards must establish criteria to declare that funds are limited or not limited. Priority for services must be given to recipients of public assistance and other low-income individuals, if funds are declared to be limited.

X Limited Funds:

The Board has established criteria to make the determination that there is limited funding in the Local Workforce Development Area and has established a priority of services policy, maintained at the local level, based on the provisions at § 663.600 of the regulations.

Not Limited Funds:

The Board has established criteria to make the determination that there is not limited funding in the Local Workforce Development Area and maintains the justification at the local level to substantiate this decision, to include the description of the criteria used to determine the availability of funds, other funding sources considered, and the needs of the specific groups within the local area that were taken into account as well other pertinent factors.
